THAI's winter schedule in effect until 24 March 2012 introduces more flight frequency on a number of routes throughout Asia.

With new aircraft entering the fleet, THAI is able to provide more convenience in scheduling and more comfort in all classes for our customers on Asia's most comprehensive airline network.

Seoul - Phuket: Direct flights 3 times weekly, in addition to double daily service between Bangkok and Seoul.

Bangkok - Kathmandu: Now 10 flights weekly with daily flights and 3 additional flights weekly.

Bangkok - Xiamen: From 3 to 4 flights weekly.

Bangkok - Chengdu: From 4 to 5 flights weekly.

Bangkok - Beijing: Now 11 flights weekly with daily flights and 4 additional flights weekly.

Bangkok - Mumbai: Now 13 flights weekly with daily flights and 6 additional flights weekly.

Bangkok - Bodgaya - Varanasi - Bangkok: Daily until 31 December 2011 and 5 flights weekly until 24 March 2012.

Bangkok - Singapore: From 4 to 5 flights daily.

Bangkok - Osaka: Now 17 flights weekly, double daily and 3 additional flights weekly.

Bangkok - Nagoya: From 10 to 11 flights weekly commencing 05 January 2012.
